Pre-meet notes Public Engagement

 Some media outlets have covered the story regarding the status of the note Liam Byrne left in 2010 for his successor as Chief Secretary to the Treasury. (Dear Chief Secretary, I'm afraid there is no money. Kind regards - and good luck! Liam). The reports state that David Laws has the note and has kept it despite requests from both HM Treasury and The National Archives to return it as it is a public record.

In the normal course of information management work with colleagues in HM Treasury in June / July 2013 we discussed the status of the above note with HMT. It was felt that the note was a public record and that it should be transferred to The National Archives. Our records indicate that HM Treasury were doing this via the Cabinet Office.
