## Records and record series of interest

Records relating to the **Colonial Office, Commonwealth and Foreign and Commonwealth Offices, Empire Marketing Board and related bodies** relating to the administration of Britain's colonies (CO), including correspondence with the colonies, government gazettes, maps (CO 700) and photographs (CO 1069)

Records relating to the transatlantic trade in **enslaved people**, including the Royal African Company (T70), records relating to transportation of enslaved people and goods (BT 6/191-193 and BT 107), registration of enslaved people (T 71) and the abolition and suppression of slave trade (FO 84)

Records relating to the **Inclosure Acts 1845-1899** (LO 3/1132), including the enclosure awards and awards of regulation of commons under the Enclosure Acts 1845 to 1899 (MAF 1)
